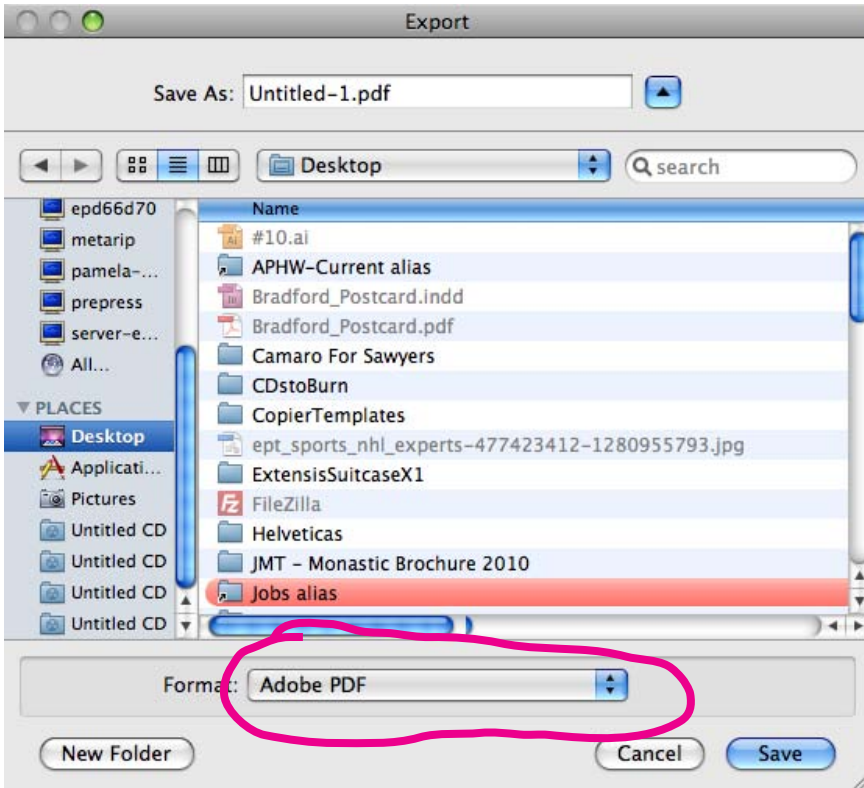
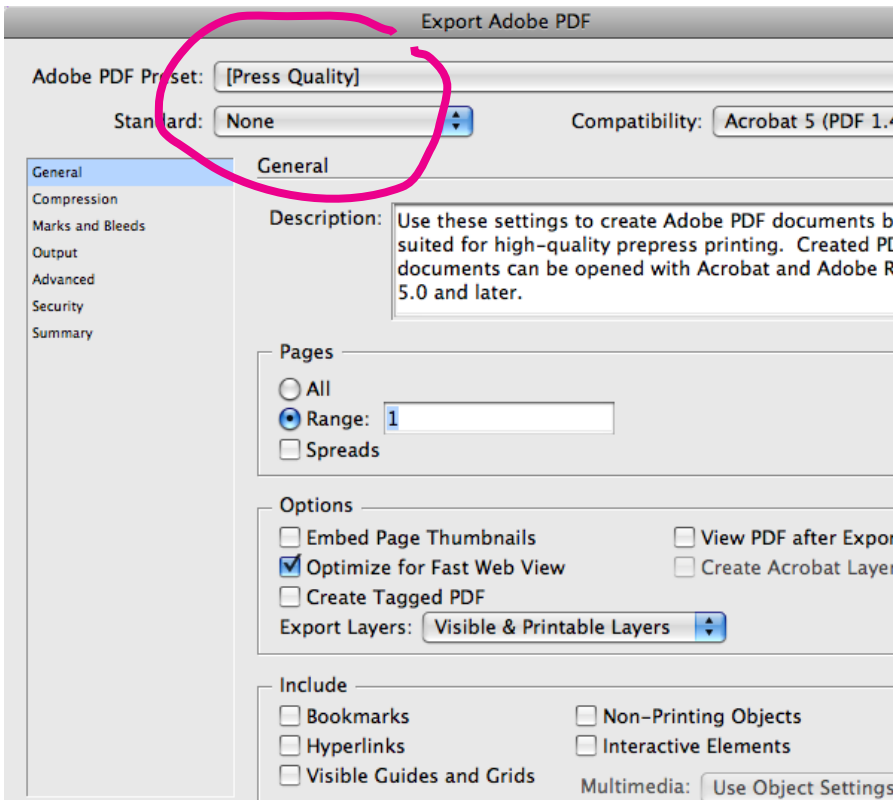


# Setting up Adobe export in Indesign for Bradford Printing.

Step 1. select export under file menu (Command E) and Format to Adobe PDF

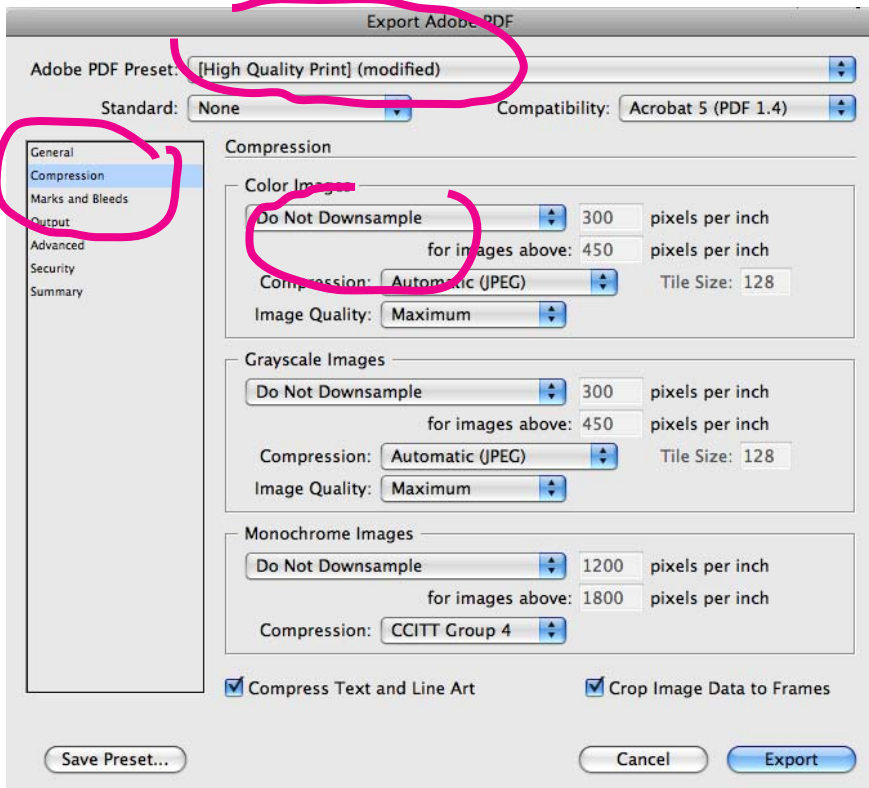


Name your file and select “Save” and this will open a new window.



Step 2:

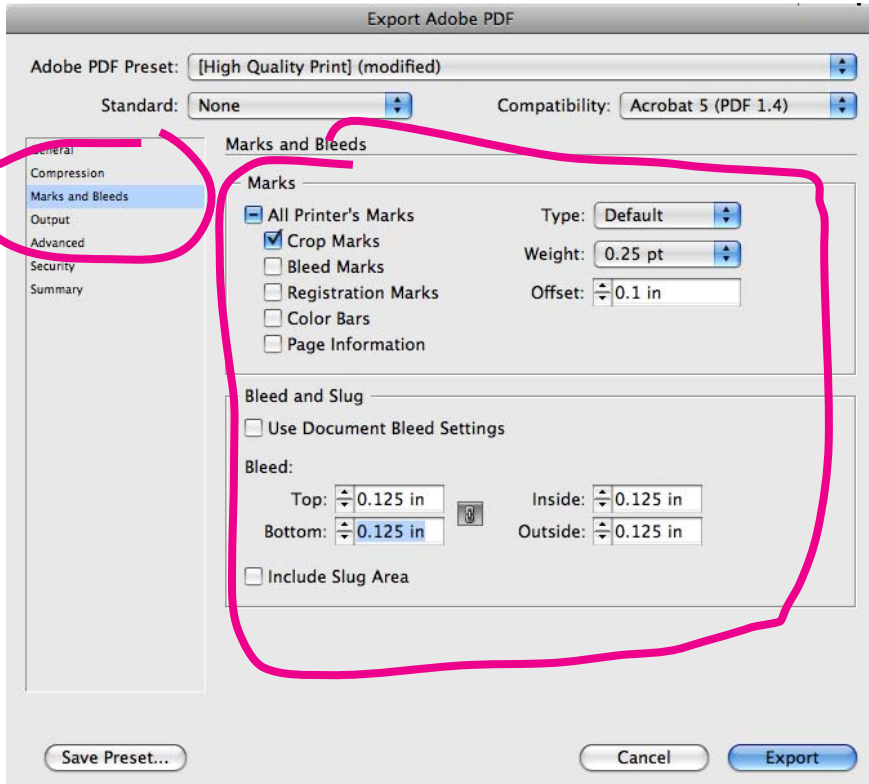
In new window select preset (Press Quality) and move to next menu item on left “Compression”



### Step 3:

Note: by selecting “Compression teh header description of (High Quality Press) will have the word modified at the end

Under Compression you will need to set all options to “Do Not Downsample”



### Step 4:

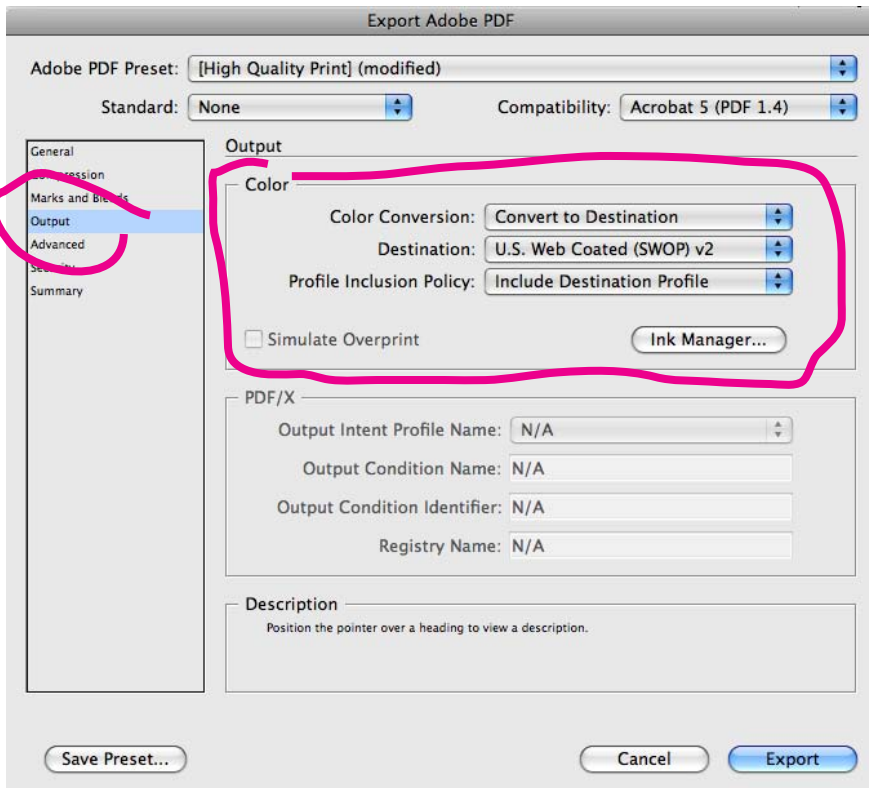
Marks and Bleeds:

Marks:

Under this menu item you will want to set only crop marks and the Off set to 0.1in

Bleed and Slug:

Set your bleed to 0.125in for all. easiest way is to besure the chain is set and this will change all at one time.



Step 4:

Color:

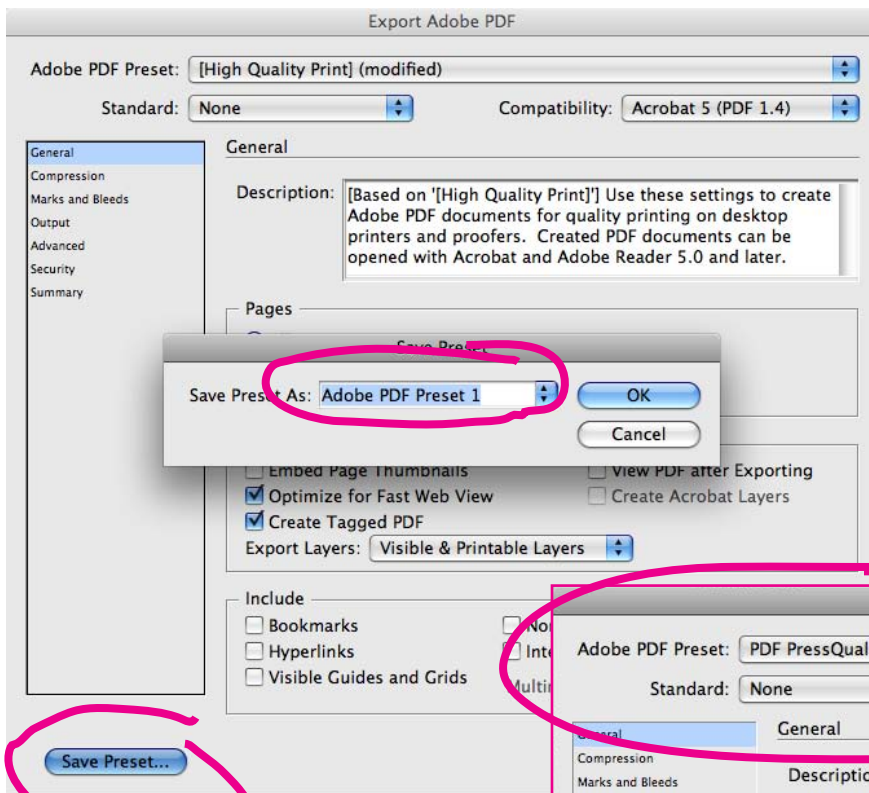
Conversion to “Convert to destination”

Destination to “U.S. Web Coated<SWOP>”

Profile inclusion policy to “Include Destination Profile”

NOTE: If you are designing a 2 color or three color change this to DO NOT convert colors. Set to NO Color Conversion setting

This will end step 4



Step 5:

Final step is to save the preset under a new name. select n the lower left the button for “Save Preset”. This will open a save window and allow you to change teh Adobe PDF Preset name.

Change name to Adobe PDF - Bradford for easy recognition of the preset.

Then when save PDF for Printing you simply export your file with the preset selected at the top.
